Students are required to arrive at school with the appropriate swimming attire under their school uniform with enclosed footwear, bring their water bottle, hat and applied sunscreen. There will be a kiosk available on the day for parents but not for students. There will be no phones or iPods permitted at the carnival with students to check in valuables at the school front office. Please ensure any medication needed for your child is registered and forms completed at the front office before Friday 12th March 2021

All students can participate in this event as we cater for all levels and abilities. Students are required to nominate for specific events at the carnival. Attached is a nomination form that allows students to nominate to compete in race events and or fun team games in shallow water. Along with this nomination your child's current swimming level must be written. Please complete the form using the Qkr! App along with payment by Friday 5th March 2021.
