Voluntary Contributions and Charges: 2025

Parent support is crucial in ensuring quality programmes are available to our students. Our Vision Statement states that parents will take shared responsibility for student growth and development. One very important way you can take 'shared responsibility' is to assist the school in providing the much needed resources that supports your child's learning.

<u>School Voluntary Contributions</u> – in line with the School Education Regulations 2000

The Baldivis Gardens Primary School - School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2025. The schedule will allow you to consider <u>possible</u> costs for 2025.

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

School Voluntary Contributions for 2025 are:

Kindergarten to Year 6

- \$60 for one child
- \$120 for two children
- \$150 for a family of three or more children

Money collected will be used to supplement school funding provided by the government.

While the contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning programs will be enhanced if each family makes a contribution. The contribution level sought represents approximately \$1.50 per student, for each week of the school year.

Money collected in 2025 will be allocated as follows:

\$20 for Literacy resources, including library resources

- \$20 for Numeracy resources
- \$20 for Science, Technology, HASS and Arts

Payments can be made by Cash, EFTPOS, QKR or via Direct Deposit. Preferred method is through QKR. To pay via Direct Deposit our banking details are BSB: 066040 Acct:19903864. Please include your child's surname, first Initial and purpose of payment.

Payment can be made in full or part payments throughout the year. Payment can also be selected at the time of placing your 2025 booklist requirements.
