

#### German in the Garden

The Baldivis Cell of primary schools are very excited to share with the community that each of the six primary schools in Baldivis will be teaching the German language. How German will be taught varies slightly in each school but each school will have access to the support of the German Languages teacher from Baldivis Primary School Mrs Helen Kuehs. Helen is a great asset to our Baldivis schools as she is a very experienced Languages teacher. In time we are hoping the secondary schools in Baldivis will offer the German Language allowing our Baldivis primary students to continue their Languages studies in the future.

At Baldivis Gardens in 2018 German will be taught, assessed and reported on in Year 3 as mandated by the Department of Education, however all students from Kindergarten to Year 6 will be exposed to the German language through our 'German in the Garden' program and the integration of German into our cross curriculum project 'From Forest to Garden'. # Lunchtime Reminders

We extend a very big thank you to the parents who are sending snacks and lunches to school in waste free containers. Help us educate our students about the importance of reducing waste, and at the same time provide healthier food for your children by reducing the amount of packaged foods in their lunch box. Please consider how much food you are sending in their lunchbox. Some children have far too much food and are not getting enough time to play as they feel they must eat what you have sent them. At lunchtime a sandwich, or a salad and a piece of fruit is more than enough. When a child has lots of additional packaged snacks they tend to eat those rather than their sandwich, salad or fruit.
