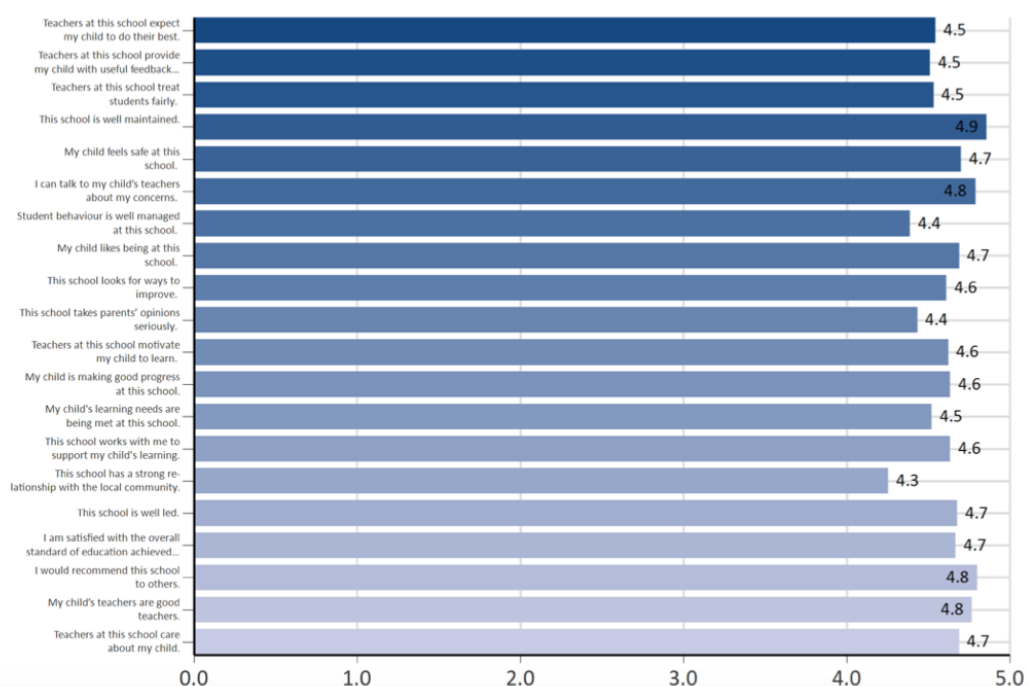


School Parent Survey Summary 2019

There were 90 responses to the school parent survey out of 307 families.
The highest response was from the Kindy classes – 20%.

The overall feedback from parents was positive, ranging from an average rating of 4.3 – 4.9.



Lowest Rating:

- The school has a strong relationship with the local community: 4.3
- Student behaviour is well managed at this school: 4.4

Highest Rating:

- The school is well maintained: 4.9
- I can talk to my child's teachers about my concerns: 4.8
- I would recommend this school to others: 4.8
- My child's teachers are good teachers: 4.8

What the school does well:

Teachers encourage, motivate, inspire and build confidence	Teachers are caring and approachable – good relationships	Fun events such as book week and colour run

What would make the school better – Factors we can control:

Provide more challenge for higher ability children	Group for Defence Force children	More fundraising activities - planned in advance giving lots of notice

A functioning P&C	The chance for dads to have more input / involvement	Christmas concert
Homework – more engaging and consistent. Sent via email / connect so parent can see the expectations	More opportunities for choir to perform	Multicultural awareness
More sporting programs for the younger children (K&PP) like footy focus	A school canteen	Shade over the play equipment

What would make the school better – Factors out of our control:
