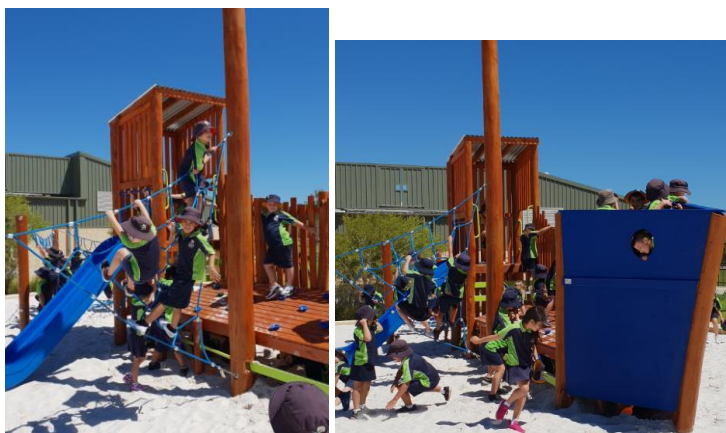

Miss Addison's Year 5 class will be hosting our first assembly Friday 22nd straight after the morning siren.

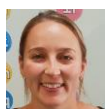
New staff
