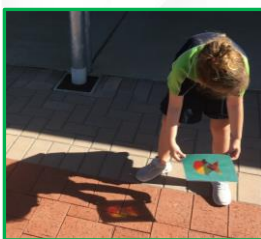
Lastly, please remember that next week is a Public Holiday on the Monday. We will see you all back on Tuesday the 5th.
